

# What about Transbay Service?

---

- AC Transit has 18 transbay routes that cross the water on two Bay Area bridges. Transbay line names begin with a letter, ex. DB, E, F, L, or NL.
- Board any of the commute-focused lines during the week. Line schedules vary with direction and time: check before you ride.
- Take full-service transbay lines F, NL, or O to San Francisco's Salesforce Transit Center during the week or weekend. Take the line U or DB to Palo Alto.
- Consider using East Bay Park & Ride lots for a small fee when space is available or catch your transbay ride at any transbay bus stop.
- Some transbay buses will be double-deckers providing lots of passenger seats along with exquisite views of the Bay.
- Once you arrive across the Bay, you will need to pay other agency fare to get around. Load cash or other agency products onto your EasyPass to pay for rides and transfers.
